**High Intensity Focused Ultrasound - 'HIFU'** 

By Dr. Edward Woods, FRCPC, Urologist, Scarborough General Hospital.

'HIFU', a relatively new treatment (in Canada) was first presented to us at our Oct 2005 meeting. Now in this session Dr. Edward Woods will discuss HIFU further, its development over the years and its future.

Dr. Edward Woods is a Toronto Urologist on staff at Scarborough General Hospital since 1988. He holds certification as a Fellow of the Royal College of Physicians of Canada.

Dr. Woods has a specific interest in new technologies in urology, including the use of lasers and minimally invasive bladder techniques and surgery. He is also actively involved in clinical research in benign prostatic hypertrophy and prostate cancer.
